Physical Quality Inspection:

- Check each process run for whole grain/colour/dust/fat coating and report issues to management/maintenance
- Compare to type samples

FP Bins Quantity Checks:

 Check bins physically to ensure bins are empty and record before different product is routed to the bins

Hygiene Housekeeping:

All area's including floors walls machinery & any other equipment

Vacuuming, Scraping, Washing & Painting

Outload Operation

- Load Lorries as required & Print and Issue drivers with relevant documentation
- Shunt & load lorries at night as required
- Ensure all spillages are cleaned up in a timely fashion
- Collect samples to be posted from outload

Raw Material Intake

- Weigh lorries in/out and sample & test as required
- Allocate vehicle to bin destination
- Collect samples to be posted from intake
- Update commercial system with relevant information
- Check empty raw material bins before using for alternate material.
- Daily check wheat grist by performing sieve test and report results to CI Manager
- Ensure intake areas are cleaned and maintained to high hygienic standard

Dispensary Operation

Preparation of Additives:

Operate Microweigh system. Record all batch numbers where applicable

Stock Replenishment & Rotation:

- Fill up the carousel as required
- Conduct strict stock rotation by ensuring oldest stock used first
- Unload bag lorries, operate fork lift truck.
- Ensure dispensary and carousel areas are cleaned and maintained to high hygienic standard
